MARINE OPERATIVE

The Marine Operative will be expected to be capable of carrying out related a wide variety of marine tasks including, but not confined to, the operation of pilot launches and other marine craft as required for port operations, vessel husbandry and maintenance, port communications, vessel traffic management system inputs, and navigational buoy and beacon maintenance.

The position is full time and normally based in Dunmore East, Co. Waterford. Candidates should reside close to Dunmore East or Waterford City.

- Applicants will be required to possess a current Passenger Boat proficiency Certificate or a Passenger Boat Commercial Endorsement for a vessel holding P5 Passenger Boat Licence and also hold the appropriate certificate for the operation VHF radios. Additionally, candidates must hold a valid medical certificate (ENG 11) and a Personal Survival at Sea certificate.
- Applicants must be familiar with marine operations in a port environment and have recent experience in the handling and operation of semi-displacement craft.
