To all ship owners, shipmasters, agents, fishing vessels, pleasure craft users, seafarers and fishery organisations.

Maintenance Ploughing Campaign

On or about Friday 24th the July, the vessel “Fastnet Sound” will conduct ploughing / bed levelling activities in the vicinity of Belview Berths, Cheekpoint Bar and Cheekpoint Harbour.

The vessel will maintain a continuous VHF watch on Channels 14 & 16, and will display regulation shapes and lights as per I.R.P.C.S. All vessels approaching the area of operations should communicate with the vessel on Channel 14 and proceed with caution, giving the vessel a wide berth.

All mariners are reminded of their responsibilities under the International Collision Regulations and are requested not to anchor or moor in the vicinity of the works.

The ploughing is expected to last approximately 6 days.
