Subsea equipment deployment

All Mariners are hereby advised that the vessel 'James' will deploy four Acoustic Doppler Current Profiling (ADCP) frames in the below locations during week commencing 01 July 2019.

A chart extract showing the approximate positions is reproduced below. The vessel will maintain a continuous VHF watch on Channels 14 & 16 during the deployment.

All Mariners are advised not to anchor or deploy fishing gear in the vicinity of the frame positions.

The frames will remain in situ for approximately 32 days.

This Notice will be withdrawn when the ADCP's are recovered.
